## **Nomination process**

Each director will nominate balanced quartets based on individual school vocal program enrollment. Send only students able to sing assigned part accurately.

- a. Under 25 students – 1 per part (4 students)
- b. 25-50 – up to 2 per part (8 students)
- c. over 50 – up to 3 per part (12 students)

Please make sure each student has good musical skills and is self-motivated to prepare the music. Remember that attendance is required at the Regional Rehearsal as well as Friday & Saturday. Students should bring pencil and music. Please continue to do the fine job you do in preparing the music with your students ahead of time. It is so important that they come with the basics learned.

Please send payment for the appropriate number of singers. (\*\*If you reserve placements for unnamed students, you are responsible for the application fees of those students. We are not able to reserve spots without payment.)

Remember that students may not perform if fees are not paid.

**Medical and Transportation Release Form** :OMEA requires that we have an Emergency Medical Authorization form for each participant as well as a transportation release form. **Lunch:** Friday: The students will have lunch in Kilcawley (Wendy's, café, etc. available). We need as many directors as possible in attendance to assist in escorting the students to Kilcawley.

**High School Concert Dress: Black Bottoms, White Tops.**

**Students may dress casually on Friday, but will need to be in concert clothes upon arrival at Stambaugh Auditorium on Saturday. They will not be able to change clothes that day.**
